## **PRINCIPAL'S CORNER - SUPER HARD CHALLENGES**

Dear Parents & Friends,

This morning I told the students about a race I'll be doing on Saturday – it's a Spartan Beast: 12-14 miles of running, 30-35 obstacles like climbing over 30-foot cargo nets and carrying 5-gallon buckets of rocks up and down hills... just for fun, you know. I'm pretty nervous about it, and honestly hoping just to finish and make it home alive and ambulatory.

But I know the feeling I will have when I do – because I've made it through some of these races before, as well as some other super hard challenges. I also have friends and acquaintances who have come through genuinely difficult challenges like beating cancer, losing a loved one and having the courage to keep living, losing a job and not knowing what's next, etc. When we come through on the other side of those things, we're stronger, more confident, and hopefully our faith that God has a plan for us has grown.

As a principal, I occasionally get to meet with students and their parents when they are facing, or in the midst of, a super hard challenge. At times, just getting through a school day can be overwhelming! One thing that separates children from adults is experience... if this is their first major hurdle, they might not have the tools to cope with it, or the same assurance that everything will work out.

That's why meetings like those are great blessings – because we get a chance to get it all out on the table, then make a plan that shows the student how to handle their super hard challenge AND reassures them that their support staff is behind them, making every effort so that their work will be successful. I love the sweet relief I see on students' faces at the conclusion of those meetings – and it's not just relief that the meeting is over, it's hope that maybe this will work out! Then, when we follow up and it has worked out, I love the new confidence and pride I see. It's a reminder to me to keep meeting the challenges head on and with faith and my team of supporters – God's got this!

You know that little red light in your car that tells you to check your engine oil? If you're anything like me, you let out a little sigh and just go about your busy day. To me, it just shows a minor issue that I can't stop my day for. It's a small matter that can wait. The thing is though, this light is important. Sure it's not as major as other warning lights in your car, but left unchecked, this minor issue can turn into a disaster!

Our marriages are no different. Every now and then we get these warning signs to check on ourselves. Little signs like forgetting to say "I love you" throughout the day. Or, because you're trying to get the kids to school on time, you have become accustomed to small pecks on the cheek instead of a true kiss good bye. I've noticed a couple "check oil" lights in my own marriage. These warning signs aren't serious right now and they aren't telling me that my marriage is failing. But if left unchecked, it can quickly turn into a disaster.

It's usually those small things that we tend to overlook. I don't want to make a small thing a big deal. I don't want to hurt my wife's feelings and I'm sure she doesn't want to hurt mine. But it's more responsible of us to make sure that these warning signs are dealt with together.

"The Lord upholds all who are falling and raises up all who are bowed down" (Psalm 145:14). We are not alone when our check lights come on. We are not abandoned on the side of the road when we tend to let those lights go on for too long and things start to go wrong. We have God! Our Lord is one who, during those mo-



ments of failures and challenges, picks us up and guides us to correction and wholeness.

Think of God as your marriage mechanic. These lights will come on now and then. You don't have to panic and trade in your car. You must first check out the issue with someone who knows how to fix it (and of course check with your spouse to make a decision). God is our help in times of need, big or small. Rely on Him, call upon His name. And never forget to keep the engine of your marriage running.

#### FLASH ALERT!

Bethlehem Lutheran School has our own Flash Alert account!

What does this mean for you? You can subscribe to our feed to receive emergency alerts (school delays or closures due to weather, etc.) and non-emergency press releases related to Bethlehem in your email and/or on your Smart Phone. We are excited about this very fast, efficient way to communicate urgent information to our families. Once you set up the account, the information will come to you!

How do you do it? On a computer, go to: http://flashalert.net/id/BLS. You can put in the email address at which you wish to receive alerts, and select the type of alert you'd like to receive (emergency alerts and/or news releases). Once you have established an account you can add additional email addresses. On a Smart Phone, search for and download the "Flash Alert" app, then search for our school; you can find us by region - Columbia Tri-Cities, and type "Private Schools." To get alerts as text messages on your Smart Phone, you will need to enter your phone number as an additional email address. This is fairly simple, but the address will be different depending on your cell phone carrier. Below are examples of the major carriers in our area - just replace the "5095551212" with your own number including the three digit area code and you're set!

We encourage you to sign up for Flash Alert. It only takes a couple

#### LUTHERAN SCHOOLS ELEMENTARY TOURNAMENT (L.E.S.T.) INFORMATION

It is time to start thinking about LEST! For those of you new to our school, LEST is a gathering of Lutheran elementary school 5th through 8th graders from Washington, Oregon, Idaho, Nevada, and California for a tournament that includes friendly competition in basketball, math, science, art, drama, spelling, chess, knowledge, bowl, swimming, to name some of to the events. The tournament is held in Portland, Oregon at Concordia University on President's Day weekend, February 16-18, 2017.

Students who are interested in participating must fill out a sign-up form that is signed by a parent. Those forms have been sent to each family in 5th-8th grade via email today. Please prayerfully consider whether your family want to attend LEST and if your child will be able to participate on the team(s) they are signing up for. They are due back in the school office by Friday, November 4.

Each family is responsible for obtaining their own lodging. Our school has stayed at Oxford Suites for many years and have once again set aside a block of rooms for Bethlehem families. Our families receive a discounted rate if you mention promo code, Bethlehem, when booking your room. To receive the discounts, you need to call Oxford Suites directly rather than using their 800 number. The direct number is (503) 283-3030. The following rooms are available:

- Studio King Suite \$105/night one King bed and a sofa sleeper
- •Executive King Suite \$110/night one King bed and a sofa sleeper
- •Studio Double Queen Suite \$122/night two Queen beds, no sofa sleeper
- Family Double King Suite \$199/night two King beds in two separate rooms, some rooms have a sofa bed, one bathroom
- Deluxe Family Double King Suite \$219/night two King beds in two separate rooms, two bathrooms

If you plan to attend LEST, we encourage you to book your room early. They go fast!

Coaches needed! If you will be going to LEST and might be interested in coaching an event, we are needing adults who would be willing to coordinate and coach the following events following the rules and guidelines of the events from the LEST manual:

#### 1. Science Team Coach

We haven't seen the LEST Manual for 2017 yet, but we are assuming they will have a Robotics Competition again this year. The following is taken from the 2016 Manual: "The LEST Robotics Competition is a new competition starting at LEST 2016. It will be held as a LEGO Sumo-Bot competition where two LEGO robot contestants try to push each other out of a circular ring. The first robot to touch the floor outside of the ring loses. The last robot remaining in the ring wins."

- 8th graders will deliver the Bethlehem Church and School-packed boxes and left over donations to the Collection Center on November 17. Parent drivers will be needed, please!

### Shoebox items suggestions:
